



SPORT GULF HARBOUR POLICIES

PHILOSOPHY

Our objective is to have as many children as we can from the area enjoying sporting activities. Some players are more competitive than others and we match these players into competitive teams, but we love nothing more than seeing new players learn and enjoy sport.

UNIFORMS

Our objective is to look smart at all times in representing Sport Gulf Harbour (SGH)

We ask that you take good care of your uniform and wash them in cold water and hang to dry.

These are to be returned at the end of the season laundered and will be collected by your Coach or manager.

Any uniform that is lost or returned in a condition that is damaged will be invoiced for the cost of a replacement.

Any netball dresses that require shortening in length, please advise your coach who will supply you with hemming tape so that it can be lengthened again at a later date.

Please ensure you do not swap your uniform with any other players as you have been assigned a serial number and you are responsible for that particular uniform.

Navy blue thermals are also the only undergarment allowed with your uniform. Please do not wear any other t-shirts or shorts with your uniform.

This uniform is not part of any schools uniform and is only to be worn while performing the sport and not as a replacement for a PE uniform at school.

Orders for the jackets will be done on a monthly basis or when orders reach over a certain number.

FEES AND CANCELLATION:

All fees must be paid before you can begin playing for your sport.

The SGH Membership is non-refundable at all times.

Team registration & Membership Fees are non-transferable and non-refundable if these have been on-paid to the relevant association.

If a member is joining part way through the season then the registration fees will be pro-rated accordingly. The SGH membership fee is payable at any time of the year.

COACHES AND MANAGERS

Thank you for your fantastic offer of support our aim is for children to participate and achieve in after school sport and to improve the way sport and physical activity services are delivered so that children are motivated and encouraged to lead healthy active lifestyles.

Below is some information that may be of help to you and please feel free to contact your delegate or committee members for any assistance.

- All children in your team must be a member of SGH.
- Each child must pay their sport fee or have an agreement with SGH for payment options
- Each child must complete a Fair Play Agreement and adhere to it
- You as the coach/manager need to read the Fair Play Agreement below and adhere to it
- Each child will hire a uniform which they need to wear at each game with pride and will return at the seasons conclusion cleaned to the coach/manager.
- Each child must not wear their uniform any other time.
- You will be given a team bag and practice balls
- Where we can we will give coaching clinics for the various sports or a coaching manual/information.
- All teams are given a Player of the Day Trophy to be given out at the coaches/managers discretion e.g. most improved, best defender. Make it a positive experience.
- In December we have our End of year Prize Giving where each child will receive a certificate and each team must select their most improved and most outstanding player.
- Also each team needs to nominate one player for our Thumbs Up Award at Prize Giving for the child who displays all around team spirit and fairplay.

Coach and Manager Fair Play Agreement:

- Respect all umpires on the court or field
- Encourage good sporting behaviour and promote Fair Play at all times
- Play fair at all times and follow up on any disputes directly with my delegate.
- Show commitment, attendance and punctuality for all games and practices
- Control my temper and language at all times
- Remember that breaking the above Rules of the Fair Play Agreement will result in suspension
